

# Best Sites For Finding HR Jobs & Three Tips For Success



## Tip #1 -- CUSTOMIZE YOUR HR RESUME.

This is an absolutely must when applying for a job at one of these sites! Review the position description carefully & tailor your resume to match the most important **“keywords”** in that description before uploading it. Your resume has a zero chance of being selected unless it’s seen as a fit for that HR job. **Yes, it takes time to "customize" - but the payoff is worth it.**

## Tip #2 -- DON'T JUST SEND OUT RESUMES, DO THIS...

Once you’ve applied for the position, regardless of what site you use, **go on LinkedIn and search for the same job posting there** and see if there’s a job poster associated to the job (this will be the recruiter who is directly working on the position for the organization).

Once you’ve found them, **send them a networking message.** While you are on LinkedIn, also check to see if you have any connections that currently work there. Whether it’s alumni from your school, former co-workers, or other people you’ve connected with throughout the years, reach out to them and **see if they can help you get an “in” at the company.**

## Tip #3 -- FINALLY, BE GRATEFUL & BELIEVE in yourself.

Be grateful for rejections, closed doors and un-returned phone calls. Why? Because it means that you're closer to landing that position is intended for you. Don't take rejection personally. Shake it off and **keep going.** Your value does not decline based on someone else's ability to see your worth. **Your time will come! Focus on what you can change. Persist.**
